Forms of participation: full-time/remote

Full-time participation assumes to represent the report with presentation doing in the program Power Point and take part in the discussion in the Leonov Moscow Region University of Technology.

Performance time limit: strictly up to 5 minutes!

Remote participation assumes to post sent materials in the conference materials collection published at the end of the conference.

Important! The originality of the article will be checked in the Anti-Plagiarism system and must be **at least 60%**



MANUSCRIPT FORMAT:

Paper length: At least 3 pages

Page size: White paper A4 (21.0 cm x 29.7 cm or 8.27" x 11.69")

Margins: standard

Font: Times New Roman, font size – 14, paragraph indentation – 1,25; line spacing – 1.

DESIGN OF ARTICLE ELEMENTS:

1. Title of the article: lowercase letters, bold, centered

2. Information about the author(s): surname of the author(s), initials, direction of training (in full), course

3. Information about the scientific supervisor: surname, initials, academic degree (if any), academic title (if any), position

4. Information about the educational institution: full name – in italics

5. City, country

6. Abstract – 200 – 500 characters.

7. Keywords: 3-4 key words.

8. The text of the article

9. References: References list is mandatory. In the body of the text, use brackets to cite a reference and put Arabic numerals inside the brackets. The order of the reference list is **alphabetical**.

Pages are **not numbered!**

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION:

There is no fee for participation in the conference.

The electronic version of the proceedings of the conference is provided free of charge. The printed version of the collection can be ordered on the publisher's website.

Hotel accommodation, meals and forwarding of materials are paid by the conference participants.

Articles are published in author edition. The author should read and examine the text. Scientific supervisor has responsibility for content of materials. Last name of the first author and the first three words of the article's title are typed in the file name.

The submitted articles are subject to mandatory verification in the Anti-Plagiarism system. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not meet the requirements and/or the topic of the conference. The proceedings is assigned the ISBN index, UDC and BBK codes.

To publish an article, it is necessary to provide the Organizing Committee with a consent for publication.
